DEFINITIONS

PUPPY - Confined to dogs of specific breed or breeds less than eighteen months of age on the date of the test

NOVICE DOG/NOVICE HANDLER (unclassified) – Neither dog nor handler to have won a 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th in an Open working test, a 1st in any test, or any award at a Field Trial including CoM.

NOVICE - A dog which has not gained a 1^{st} in a Novice Working Test. $1^{st} 2^{nd}$ or 3^{rd} in an Open Test or any awards in Field Trials.

OPEN - Open to any dog.

The Meet and Running Order:

Please report to the secretary upon arrival to collect armbands and a running order.

Puppy/Novice/NDNH to meet at 9am for a 9.30am start.
